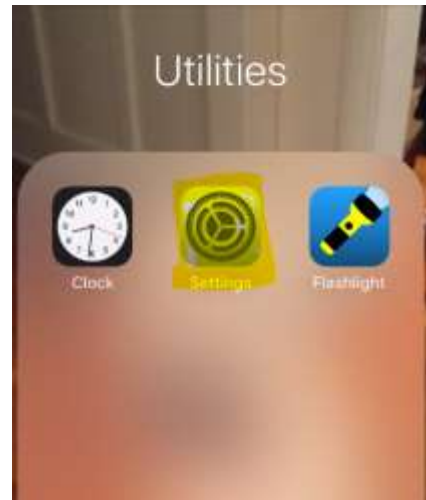


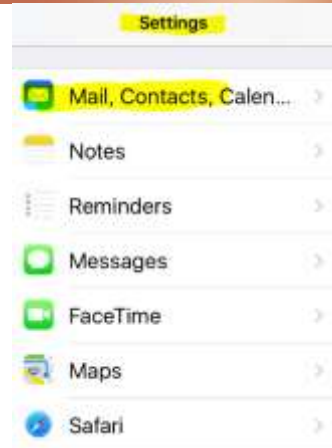
Setting up Your Armada Data Email Account on iOS 9 devices using the “Mail” app.

There have not been many changes in the setup of POP and IMAP accounts on iOS 9 but please refer to the directions below. The key elements are highlighted in yellow.

Step 1 is to select the settings icon on your device



Step 2 is to scroll down and select “Mail, Contacts, Calendar”



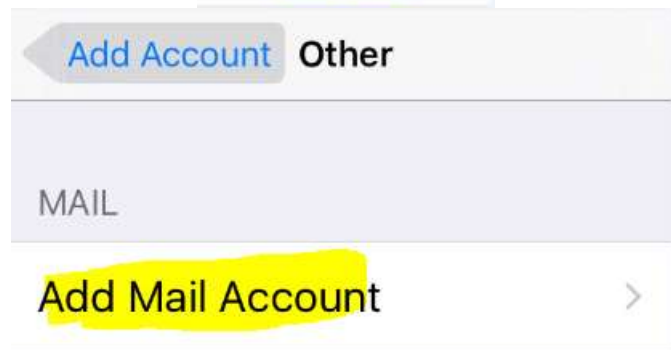
Step 3 is to select “Add Account”



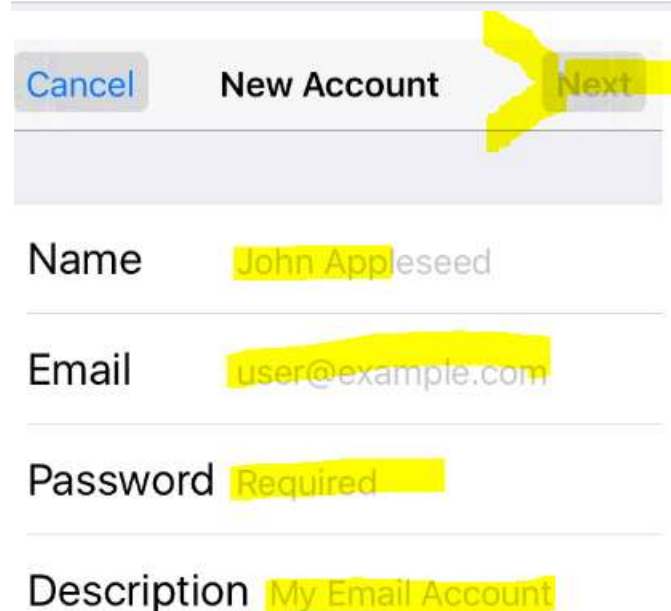
Step 4 is to select "Other"




Step 5 is to select "Add Mail Account"



Step 6 is to fill in the blanks with the account information that we provided.




Step 7: After you have filled in the blanks, select the “Next” in the top right corner


Step 8: Leave the IMAP section highlighted in Blue (you don't need to change this setting). Scroll down and fill in the blanks with the mail server name we provided. Which was “mail.armadadata.com”. Be sure to also enter your email address and password. Then keep scrolling down.

This is what it should look like.



Step 9: Enter the Outgoing Mail Server name. Basically you are going to exactly enter the same info as you did for the Incoming Mail Server. Then select the “Next” in the top right corner.



Step 10: Your device will now “Verify” the information and your account. This could take several minutes. Please wait until it finishes. When is it done you will see the screen on the right, please select the “Save” option in the top right corner.



You are done and you should be able to see your email in the "Mail" program.
